GENERAL USE ICE PACKS

Our ice packs made with our STAY-DRY® construction deliver up to 2.5 hours of consistent, dry cold therapy. They feature a 3-layer construction, which helps reduce wetness due to condensation. And they’re available with ties or hook & loop straps for added support and versatility.

We also offer a convenient STAY-DRY® hanging dispensing system which takes seconds to attach, on or next to an ice machine.†

When Cold Therapy is required for extended use, we also offer our Soft ‘N Cold Ice Pack which features a soft knit covering for additional comfort.

INSTANT ICE PACKS

Our best-selling HAND-AID[®] Arterial Wrist Support has padding that makes it easier to achieve an arterial puncture with a patient's wrist in the hyper-extended position. It also has a foam starter block that helps provide a better view and helps facilitate the successful insertion of a catheter on the first try. And it includes replacement pads, straps and starter block which enable reuse of the plastic base.

To help reduce irritation and limit the possibility of infection at an I.V. site, I.V. supports are employed during the initial stages of I.V. placement. They may be used to stabilize a patient's wrist; or, if an antecubital view is being accessed, a forearm or elbow.

Unlike some I.V. supports, which use harsh tape that can irritate skin, our entire line of HAND-AID[®] I.V. supports is designed with you in mind. They feature soft, adjustable hook & loop straps. They allow for a secure, custom fit for all patients, and they're easy to adjust for repositioning and removal. TELEMETRY UNIT POUCHES



After a patient suffers a heart attack or undergoes cardiac surgery, he must be monitored by telemetry equipment. Telemetry Unit Pouches (TUPs) are used to secure telemetry transmitters to the patient, help prevent artifacts (static) in the information relay from the transmitter to the CMS, and help prevent transmitters from falling off or being subjected to food or drink spills.

Halyard Health has a complete line of Telemetry Unit Pouches with neck and waist straps that adjust easily to fit the patient. All of our TUPs have name/room number labels to clearly identify the patient. And all are large enough to fit any size transmitter.

Our water-resistant CLEARVIEW* TUP with ties features a clear front panel which allows for easy viewing of the transmitter, while the resalable adhesive closure provides nursing convenience. Our telemetry unit pouch with hook & loop straps is made with moisture-resistant Teclin material. The foam inner liner

secures the telemetry transmitter and prevents it from sliding during patient activity. The double strap with hook & loop attachment design allows for easy application and universal sizing while providing even distribution of weight for maximum patient comfort.
